The 10th edition of the CSI InApp International Student Project Awards has been launched on 18th January 2021. InApp has been organizing these awards in association with CSI (Computer Society of India), Trivandrum Chapter for students of engineering and science colleges in India from 2012. The award is initiated to recognize and promote Bachelor's Degree students across the globe who demonstrate exceptional talent in developing software applications. The award is juried by veterans from IT industry and cash prizes of Rs 50,000 and Rs 25,000 respectively are given for the best two student teams along with an award plaque.

Proudly, for the 10th edition, we join hands with the Kerala Technological University as our Academic partner to take this competition to the International stage and have invited students from foreign universities also to submit their original project work to be considered and evaluated by pioneers in the technology field. A number of CSI members other than office bearers contributed to the successful launch of awards. 




The theme of our hackathon will be innovations for differently abled categories of people. Participants can choose any of the problem statements provided below and make their own creative innovation on the above theme.
